Dr. McCarter has previously served on the Laboratory Standards Development Technical Advisory Panel of The Joint Commission and Healthcare Infection Control Practices Advisory Committee of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Dr. McCarter has presented more than 80 invited presentations at the local, regional, national, and international levels. She is nationally recognized for her work in cost-effective, clinically-relevant microbiology. Her research interests include utilization controls in the Clinical Microbiology Laboratory, cost-effective laboratory medicine and the evaluation of new diagnostic tests and antimicrobials.

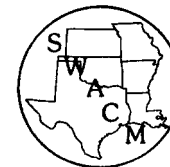
